POLICY ON

EDGE LINE MARKINGS ON WASCO COUNTY ROADS

April 19, 2000

The 2000 edition of the Manual for Uniform Traffic Control Devices states edge line markings *shall* be placed for paved traveled ways on streets and highways that are rural arterials, 20 feet or more in width, with the average daily traffic of 6000 or greater. *Wasco County shall stripe those roads.*

The 2000 MUTCD also states that edge line markings *should* be placed on paved traveled ways for streets and highways that are rural collectors with 20 feet or more in width. *Wasco County's policy is to put edge markings on roads that have adverse weather conditions.*

For example, we will put fog lines on Sevenmile Hill Road because of the frequency of snow, ice, and fog on a curvy route. However, we will not put fog lines on Long Hollow Road because it is in a dryer part of the county with better visibility, less curvature, and lower ADT's.
